Natural city Pokhara with panoramic mountains, Beautiful Lakes and greenery hills This program from Discovery Mounatin Trek starts from Kathmandu. Visit the historical cities Bhaktapur durbar squire, Pashpatinath temple dedicated to Lord Shiva. Guhyeswori and Jalaranayan. Drive to Manakamana temple a will fulfilling goddess visit with cable car ride. Peoples believed that Manakamana temple of goddess Bhagawati grant the wishes to all who worship in the temple.

Journey reaches at Muktinath temple by short and scenic flight with tiny aircraft from Pokhara airport. Muktinath temple is believed by both Hindu and Buddhist. Worshipping in the temple and taking bath at 108 taps believe to wash sins. Muktinath area is mountain terrain of scenic landscape. It provides Himalayan views of Mount Nilgiri, Dhaulagiri and Annapurna rages. Program also has designed two nights stay in Pokhara. Boating program at Fewa Lake, visit Barahi temple, Gupteswor Mahadev cave, David falls, Bindabasini temple with close view of Annapurna Himalayan range.

Janaki Temple It is the primary temple of maithali native indigenous to Nepal. Janaki temple is the hindu temple of janakpur in Mithila region of Nepal, dedicated to the hindu goddess Sita. It is a three stories structure made entirely of stone and marble. According to the legends King Janak ruled this area –call Videha, during the Ramayana period. His daughter janaki (Sita), during her swyambar, had chosen lord Rama as her husband, and become queen of Ayodhya. Their marriage ceremony had occurred in the nearby Temple.

Details Itinerary

DAY 1 : ARRIVAL IN KATHMANDU AND TRANSFER TO HOTEL

A quick welcome at the airport and transfer to your hotel. Your guide gives you a brief of the program, After you get some refreshment and rest in the hotel, Take an evening stroll around the Thamel and stay overnight at the hotel.

DAY 2 : DRIVE FROM KATHMANDU TO POKHARA VIA MANOKAMANA 6/7H DRIVE

After breakfast we start drive via Manokamana through scenic and windy road to Pokhara. And we stop on the way at Kurintar for cable ride to Manokamana temple doing the darsan and wishing fulfilling Goddess. After darsan back the cable station then we and drive continue to Pokhara.

DAY 3 : FLY FROM POKHARA TO JOMSOM AND DRIVE TO MUKTINATH BACK TO JOMSOM

Early in the morning drive to Pokhara airport for flight to Jomsom. It is 15 minutes flight which is one of the scenic flight over dense forest, hills and mountain. We reach at Jomsom airport which is different landscape and weather. After landing jomsom airport we take you to your Lodge, have some tea and get ready for jeep ride to Muktinath temple, Holy bath at 108 taps around the temple. Worship Muktinath temple and hiking around to visit other sites. Drive back again to Jomsom for overnight

Jomsom to Muktinath by jeep: 50 Minutes

Pokhara to Jomsom flight: 15 minutes

DAY 4 : FLY FROM JOMSOM TO POKHARA 15 MINUTES FLIGHT

Early in the morning fly back to Pokhara. Sightseeing at major sites in Pokhara: Bindabasini temple, David falls, Gupteswar Mahadev. Boating tour at Fewa lake and visit Tal barahi temple and overnight at hotel.

Pokhara to Jomsom flight: 15 minutes

DAY 5 : DRIVE FROM POKHARA TO JANAKPUR 11H DRIVE

After your breakfast you will proceed to Janakpur via Chitwan National Park and East-West Highway of Nepal. It is the primary temple of Maithali native indigenous to Nepal. Janaki Temple is the Hindu temple of Janakpur in Mithila region of Nepal, dedicated to the Hindu goddess Sita. The temple is fully made in white and constructed in an area of 4860 sq feet in a mixed style of Islamic and Rajput domes. It is a three-story structure made entirely of stone and marble. According to the legends, King Janak ruled this area—called Videha, during the Ramayana period. His daughter Janaki (Sita), during her Swayambar, had chosen Lord Rama as her husband, and became queen of Ayodhya. Their marriage ceremony had occurred in the nearby Temple.

DAY 6 : FLIGHT FROM JANAKPUR TO KATHMANDU 40 MINUTES FLIGHT

Early in the morning, visiting at Janaki Temple, Dhanusha Dham and later on you will fly from Janakpur to Kathmandu. You will transfer to your Hotel. In the evening you will go for sightseeing in Kathmandu at Pashupatinath and Mata Guheswori Temple.

DAY 7 : KATHMANDU: SIGHTSEEING

Early in the morning, drive to Bhaktapur Durbar Square and Dolewshor Old Shiva Temple and drive back to Hotel. Later if you have more time, you can take for Jalnarayan Temple (Budhanilkanth). In the evening, you are invited to join us for a farewell dinner.

DAY 8 : DEPARTURE TO YOUR DESTINATION

Today your trip comes to the end. And according to your schedule, we will take you to the airport for your flight ahead.

ACCOMMODATIONS

We will be staying at Hotel Manaslu in Kathmandu and lake view resort in Pokhara or similar 3 star hotel. Star and guest houses in Jomsom. All accommodations are on twin-shared basis. Also note that single rooms are readily available in Kathmandu and Pokhara the trekking regions at lower elevation but it might be difficult.

MEALS

All meals Kathmandu and pokhara will be yours own while only bed and breakfast will be available in Kathmandu and Pokhara. But in Jomsom and Janakpur all meals Lunch, Dinner and breakfast will be include the price. There will also be welcome and farewell dinners for you in Kathmandu. While on trek, we have breakfast and dinner in the tea-houses/ lodges we spend the night. Nepalese, Tibetan, the more common continental and Indian cuisines are common choices in the menu.

BEST TIME TO TRAVEL

The best time to travel this trip is in spring (February to May) and autumn (September to November). The temperature is moderate in these seasons and guarantees amazing views through the trip. Although this trek can be undertaken during winter, the cold temperature might not be suitable for everyone.

Please note the trip cost is required to make in advance as per the company policy, this deposit help us to make confirm reservation of Hotels in City,

domestic flights and all other trip arrangements for final trip booking. Along with deposit we need detailed name lists of participants, same as passport, Gender, Nationality, Date of birth, passport number, passport issue/ Expiry dates & profession. You need to send us passport copy, photo identity and e-ticket by e-mail for all trips in Nepal.

Cancellation Policy

If any reason you have to cancel your trip, we Discovery Mountain Trek require written confirmation of your decision. The amount you have paid to us will be refunded according to the following terms:

- Cancellation more than 35 days before your departure date: \$60 will charged
- Cancellation more than 35 to 19 days before your departure date: your deposit, 25% will charged
- Cancellation more than 18 to 10 days before your departure date: 50% will charged
- Cancellation more than 9 to 05 days before your departure date: 75% will charged
- Cancellation less than 4 days before your departure date: 100% of the total will charged
